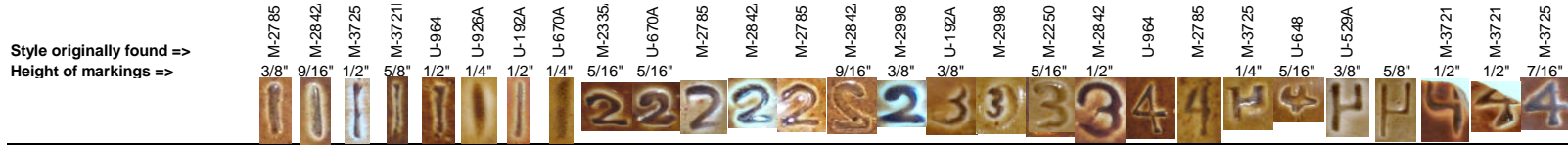

Marking Locations
c - side of crown
e - ear (helmets)
s - side skirt
is - inner skirt
t - top of skirt
tc - top of crown
u - underside of top skirt
f - firing rest
x - unspecified (multiparts are usually marked under top of skirt)

Marking Notes
Number Codes - found on 1902-1904 specimens only
Letter Codes - appear 1903 and later with N-N, Victor, but not with R=oo logo marking
1905-1908 Victor marked multiparts - letter code usually appears on firing rest
F-L - Marked Fred Locke, unspecified or unreadable marking
N-N - No name specimens that clearly have 1905-1908 manufacturing characteristics (after Fred, before Victor)
